Hanging

Use the enclosed bar (inside the tube) to hang the work—

1. Using a level, nail each end of the bar to the wall (**make sure the holes are angled down**).
2. Slip the bar off the nails (leaving the nails in the wall).
3. Slide the bar into the sleeve on backside of the work (**with holes angled down**).
4. Position the bar/work on the nails.
5. Center the work making sure the nails are ‘just exposed’ with the bar and the bar can’t be seen.

Storing and Shipping

1. Lay down the bubble wrap.
2. Put the cloth on top of the bubble wrap.
3. Put the work (**surface down**) on top of the cloth.
4. Position the tube at the top of the work. (Put hanging bar in the tube.)
5. Roll the bubble wrap, cloth, work and tube together. As you roll, **the quilt surface should face out**. This prevents wrinkles on the surface.
6. Tape the plastic sheet around the roll.
7. Slide the roll into the box and seal.
